The Central Coast comprises many different regions, most notably Monterey County, Santa Lucia Highlands, Santa Barbara County, San Luis Obispo and Paso Robles. What makes regions here so special is the soil and the mountains. Most of the mountain ranges of the Central Coast run east-west and not north-south, meaning these areas are completely exposed to the cooling Pacific breeze.

Toss in heavy nighttime fog, extended daily sunshine, and a dash of clay-rich soil, and you have the perfect recipe for a region well-suited to growing cool-climate varieties like Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Syrah, and even Cabernet Franc.

Regional producers have been steadily gaining popularity in recent years for their great iterations of these varieties. Keep an eye out for wines from Calera, Bonny Doon, Blue Canyon, Rhys, Diora, Talbott, and McBride Sisters.







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You may be familiar with Monterey County's historic landmarks. The Monterey Bay Aquarium, the cliffs of Big Sur, and the historical village of Carmel-by-the-Sea are staples of California tourism. What you may not be familiar with is the fact that the region has been producing standout wines since the early 1970s, thanks to its unique terroir. (19년 전 1997) 일, 1997年3月 - 지 당 한 년 (1917년) 왕



The valley floor where much of Monterey's grapes are grown is bitterly cold in comparison with the rest of California (i.e., less-than-ideal surfing weather) and very windy, making it one of the few places in California that thin-skinned grape varieties can thrive. These conditions, coupled with low rainfall and the omnipresent California sunshine, lead to one of the longest growing seasons in North America, perfect for crafting cool-climate wines.

Grapes grown in Monterey County are full of personality. Pinot Noir from Monterey is concentrated, herbaceous and earthy, whereas Chardonnay will offer notes of white peach and a razor-fine acidity. These commonalities are a distinct contrast to the bold, boisterous wines the rest of California is famous for producing.



# WOMEN IN WINE

#### McBride Sisters: Making Monterey magic

Two sisters from two ends of the earth sharing one dream. These are the roots of the largest Blackowned wine company in the United States.

Half-sisters Andréa and Robin grew up on opposite sides of the planet. Andréa was raised in Marlborough, New Zealand, and Robin in Monterey, California; two regions known for producing great wines of similar qualities.

Destiny certainly played its hand for the sisters, who would combine their shared talents and love for wine to start their own wine distribution business in 2005. They based their business in the Central Coast, as the pair were familiar with the Coast's capability to grow the great cool-climate varieties they were both accustomed to, such as Pinot Noir and Sauvignon Blanc.

Andréa and Robin have been heralds for change in the wine industry, with a selfless goal in mind: to bring forth much-needed change to the inequality and lack of representation of women and people of colour in the wine industry, all while keeping sustainable, inclusive practices.

This ideology is reflected in products like the SHE CAN canned wine collection. A portion of sales goes to the SHE CAN Professional Development Fund, which donates to future female entrepreneurs around the world.

The McBride sisters have proudly released the Black Girl Magic line, which is described as "a personal ode to their culture and story ... inspired by the magic and resilience of Black women, to be enjoyed by all."

# LCBO SPIRIT OF SUSTAINABILITY

The story of Tenute Orestiadi begins with Ludovico Corrao. He was mayor of Gibellina, Sicily, in 1968 when a powerful earthquake levelled the town. A "visionary," according to Alessandro Costantini, who is Tenute Orestiadi's brand ambassador for Canada, Corrao made it his life's work to reimagine the town as a centre of cultural exchange for the Mediterranean area. He invited Italy's most prominent artists and architects to contribute designs, installations and sculptures that would make the reborn town, named Gibellina Nuova, a living museum.

It was in this context of creativity and possibility that Tenute Orestiadi was founded in 2008, envisioned as a connection between the local wine industry and the artistic movement that Corrao had begun. In partnership with Corrao and his Orestiadi Foundation, they embarked on several social and creative projects to showcase the town and uplift the local economy.

Caring for the people means caring for the land. Tenute Orestiadi's measures to increase energy efficiency and reduce  $CO_2$  emissions include installing solar panels, becoming a RafCycle partner to recycle label liner waste, joining the ETICO project to recycle corks, and sourcing lighter bottles made from 60 to 89% recycled glass.

After Corrao's death at age 84, Tenute Orestiadi commited themselves to keeping his vision alive. "Today, Tenute Orestiadi and Orestiadi Foundation face each other from the top of two hills and they are managed by the same people," Costantini says. They never forget that "behind the winery there are 1,200 family members of grape growers" and that "our responsibility is to improve the quality of life of our people."

# TO BE FRANC...

A natural fit for Ontario's cool climate, Cabernet Franc is also a cool choice for wintry dinners.

Thanks to its herbaceous, savoury character, Cabernet Franc is an incredibly versatile grape able to make delicious single-varietal wines or add a little spice to a red blend. *Vintages* writer Gabriel Corindia interviewed winemakers from four popular local wineries to find out what makes Ontario such a great place to grow Cabernet Franc and why it's the perfect wine for winter.

"Wine consumers are starting to realize that bigger is not always better. Cabernet Sauvignon can be overly full-bodied, tannic and boozy, while Cabernet Franc has more intrinsic balance," say **Creekside** winemakers Yvonne Irvine and Rob Power.

When asked why Cabernet Franc is well-suited for Ontario's climate, they add, "Despite all that Mother Nature throws at us, Cabernet Franc seems to acclimatize well to this region. It survives through colder winters and ripens consistently year to year.

"Cabernet Franc is an absolute gem of a wine in the cold, dark days of winter. It pairs so well with heartier dishes like stews, long-simmered soups and sauces, or braised meats. It's also just fine by itself while you sit curled up next to a fire on a stormy night."

It's like a match made in heaven; a grape

that thrives in our challenging climate and pairs equally well with it.


"At the turn of the century, when most of Prince Edward County grapes were being planted, Cabernet Franc was a sort of gamble," says **Casa-Dea** winemaker Kalvin Holland. As it turns out, this region is well-suited for its growth.

"We're located near the Hillier community of Prince Edward County. This area of Prince Edward County is a moderately shallow soil on limestone shale. Cabernet Franc grows best in this type of soil and is a vigorous vine that enjoys the excess of minerals limestone provides. I believe that the growth this soil generates is directly correlated to the bold tannins in a Cabernet Franc."

Bold tannins, hefty weight and robust minerality are great for making Cabernet Franc so winter-friendly. As Holland puts it, "It's like bottled warmth. Jammy fruit and baking spices make a good Cabernet Franc an excellent winter standalone wine, as well as a perfect pairing for big hearty dinners."

"Cabernet Franc was kind of the 'little brother' grape. He would hang out with his older brother Cabernet Sauvignon and his friends to get noticed," says **Kew Vineyards** winemaker Levi de Loryn. "Now, we're seeing Cabernet Franc in the spotlight. Little Brother's gotten big and strong and has overtaken his brother's spot as the big chief."

"I think finally people are realizing that they've enjoyed Cabernet Franc in blends for years, and with an improvement of quality, they're beginning to understand how Cabernet Franc can make great single-varietal wines," says **Thirty Bench** winemaker Emma Garner. "There was a



time when the Cabernet Franc produced here was weedy, unripe, and lacking colour and structure. Now, the wines are amazing!"

Well-developed fruit leads to a healthy growing season and many possibilities. De Loryn says, "What makes Cab Franc so exquisite in Niagara and beyond is its versatility. We see Cab Franc in blends, as Icewine, in sparkling wine, rosé, we've even seen it made using the appassimento method. It's so flexible, both for winemakers and consumers.

"Cabernet Franc seems to go with so many great parts of Ontarian culture." Couldn't have said it better ourselves.


