Torres & Earth: Partnering for the future

Collaboration & creativity & commitment. A complex problem like climate change requires them all.


Like many others, Miguel A. Torres was woken up to the climate crisis by the 2006 documentary An Inconvenient Truth. He saw that Familia Torres, his fifth-generation family winery that dates back to 1870, faced an uncertain future. So he took action, starting the Torres & Earth project in 2008. The results have been remarkable.

In 2022, Familia Torres achieved a 36% reduction in CO₂ emissions per bottle compared to 2008. As for their ambitious goal of reaching a 60% reduction by 2030 and becoming a net zero winery by 2040, "our sustainability manager keeps saying that we will make it," Mr. Torres assures.

Getting here has involved a reimagining of almost every aspect of the business. Photovoltaic panels and geothermal energy reduce the use of fossil fuels in winery buildings, reservoirs store rainwater to reduce water use, and in 2012 Torres installed the largest biomass boiler of any Spanish winery. The boiler, which runs on pruned canes, old vines, pomace and stems, has considerably reduced gas consumption and avoided CO2 emissions.

Torres now reuses 45% of its purified water, produces 55% of its electricity and recycles 99% of its waste. And within the next two years, "there is no manager that will drive a [company] car that is not electric," says Mr. Torres. This commitment has seen him named one of the 100 most influential people leading climate action globally in TIME magazine's December 4, 2023 issue.

The future will see Torres continue to develop creative solutions, such as their pioneering carbon-capture-reuse system using the CO2 created during wine fermentation. It will see them expand their 130+-hectares of trees planted, since as Mr. Torres points out, "every tree we grow means five kilos of carbon dioxide per year" removed from the atmosphere. It will also see them pursue collaboration, like building the International Wineries for Climate Action (IWCA) group they co-founded in 2019. Climate change is a global problem that affects all wineries, so the solution must be global as well. It's Mr. Torres's hope that "we can make wine as a way of presenting our resilience against climate change."

Packaged in an earth-friendly lightweight bottle, the bright, juicy Altos Ibéricos Crianza 2019 is what Mr. Torres calls "a classic Rioja wine," with the emphasis on vibrant red fruit. Unsurprisingly, he suggests a climateconscious food pairing: "I love to eat lentils and chickpeas, and I think this wine goes very well with traditional Spanish cooking" like lentejas or garbanzos con espinacas.

ATEAM EFFORT


Committed to a focus on quality over quantity, the team at Hidden Bench uses a roster of sustainable practices to craft wines that garner local and international acclaim.

For 20 years, Hidden Bench has been a determined proponent of an organic, sustainable, non-interventionist approach to crafting fine wine. Vigneron Harald Thiel spoke with *Vintages* writer Teige Reid about the hard work his team continues to put in; work that has seen Hidden Bench named Winery of the Year at the 2023 National Wine Awards of Canada and receive critical acclaim the world over





LOCAL TALENT







"We have always emphasized quality over quantity," says Harald Thiel. "Our team believes that as estate wine growers, the big quality difference from others can be linked back to our commitment to only craft wine with certified-organic (Pro-Cert) grapes that we grow on our farm. Being a certified-organic winery is not for the faint of heart in this environment of climate change, but as artisan organic wine growers, we have the ultimate control over the quality of the most important component of our wine: the grapes."


The amount of time, the attention to detail, and the personal energy required

to make wines in this fashion are considerable, as are the costs. But as Harald points out, the team at Hidden Bench are committed to "crafting premium, terroir-driven expressions of the Beamsville Bench." It's a goal that does not allow for compromise and one that requires a steadfast team that are all on the same page.

Among the many sustainable practices at work behind the scenes at Hidden Bench are the geothermal heat pumps that heat and cool their winery, the 105 solar panels that power the winery buildings, and "the onsite weather stations that monitor temperature, humidity, wind, etc.

Because we are an organic wine grower," Harald explains, "we have no silver bullet for dealing with powdery mildew and the other diseases that can impact a crop, so we have to remain vigilant and make informed viticulture and winemaking decisions to prevent the problems ahead of time. Technology has always been part of our sustainable mission and we are always looking at ways to improve." In that spirit, the Hidden Bench team are exploring the viability of electric tractors.

Sustainability is not merely about maintaining, it's about growing. Hidden Bench recently acquired a new parcel of land adjacent to their estate vineyard.





"We are very excited about this exceptional site, as it will give us a new limestone/clay terroir palette to work with. The site will be planted primarily to Cabernet Franc, as we intend to craft a single-vineyard Beamsville Bench expression of this grape variety. We will be planting additional Chardonnay and Pinot Noir as well as a trial parcel of Pinot Meunier for our growing traditional-method sparkling program."
