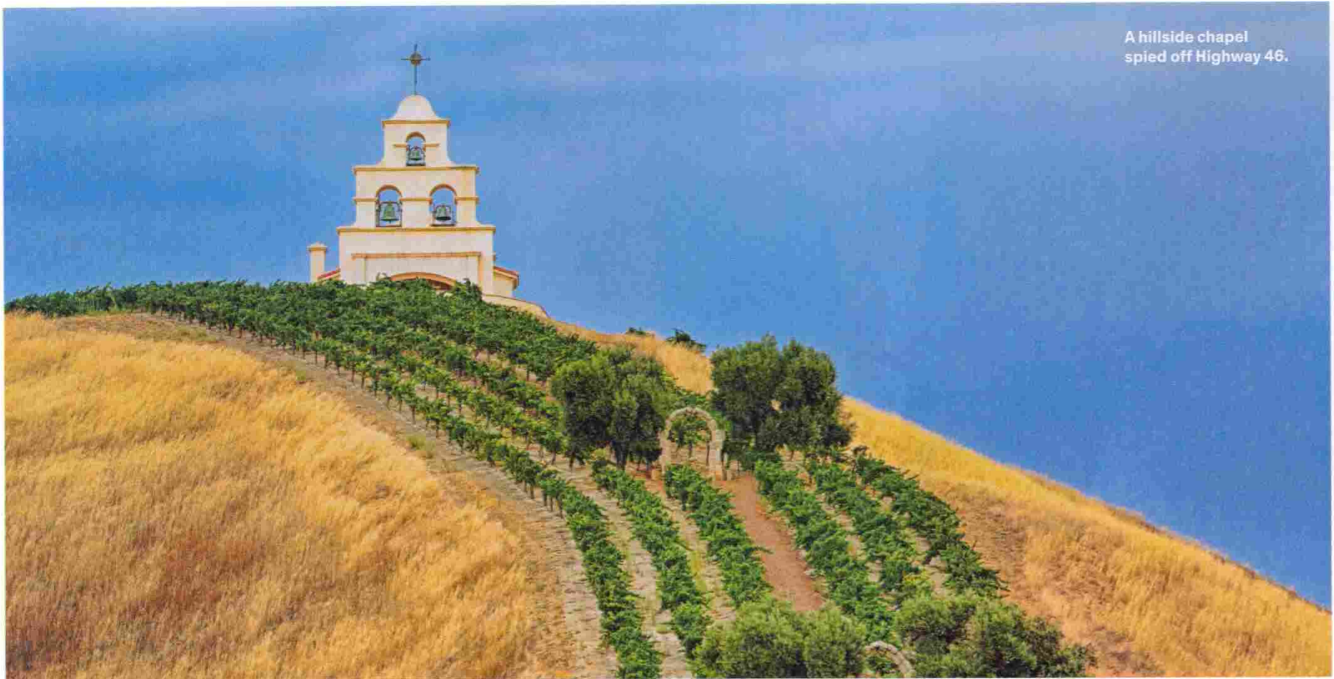
# HERE'S A REGION TO WATCH **PASO IT ON**

Though it's one of California's lesser-known AVAs, **Paso Robles** is a powerhouse in its own right.

Looking for the inside track on a hot "new" wine region that offers top-tier quality at approachable prices? Two words: Paso Robles. Paso has more than 230 years of winemaking history, yet still flies under the mainstream radar. But that won't last; it's attracting a lot of attention these days and many big names in the wine world have been taking notice – you should too.

## CALIFORNIA'S OTHER GEM

When it comes to California wine, Napa and Sonoma are rightly top of mind. But in the shadow of these two giants, Paso Robles has been quietly producing stunning wines, notably Cabernet Sauvignon. Paso's diverse, complex geography of rolling hills, flatlands, river bottoms, valleys and mountains has created a patchwork of growing areas. With vineyards planted in hot, dry areas or sites cooled by Pacific Ocean fogs and breezes, this varied landscape allows Cabernets Sauvignon and Franc, Zinfandel, Merlot, Petite Sirah, Syrah, Viognier, Roussanne and others to thrive.

The 2020 Quest is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc sourced from sites in El Pomar, Creston, Geneseo, Estrella, Paso Robles Highlands and San Juan Creek. It was aged in 65% new American oak. Look for a ripe, balanced wine, with ripe cherry, dark chocolate, oak spice, vanilla, and a lifted mint tone.

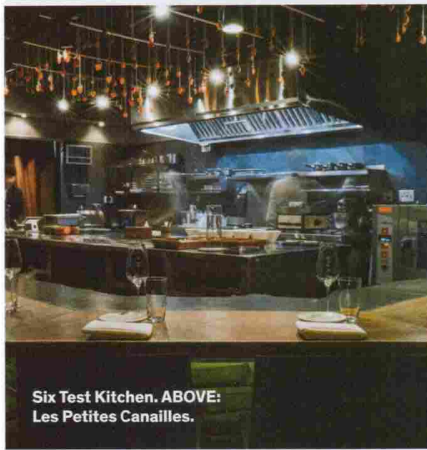

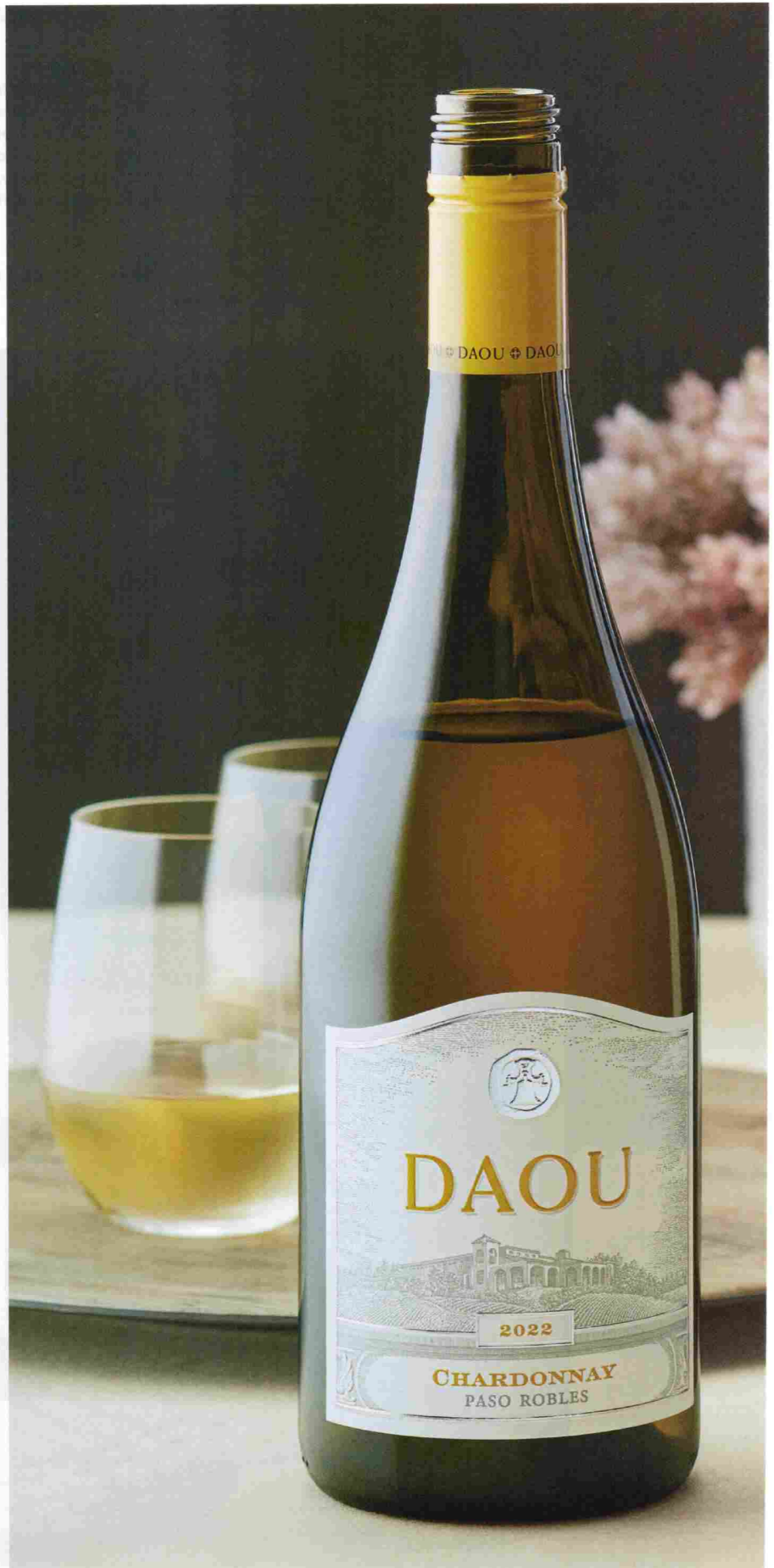

The 2022 Chardonnay Estate underwent full malolactic conversion and matured for 11 months in 100% new oak. It has youthful but classy new oak aromas of toast, vanilla and spice over a core of yellow apple, quince and honeyed tones. The medium-bodied palate is luxuriously satiny, concentrated and ripe, its nuanced fruit enlivened by surprisingly fresh acidity. It has a touch of old-school, tropical malolactic character, yet streaks of matchstick keep it tethered to the ground. Lovely! Drink date: 2025-2035. 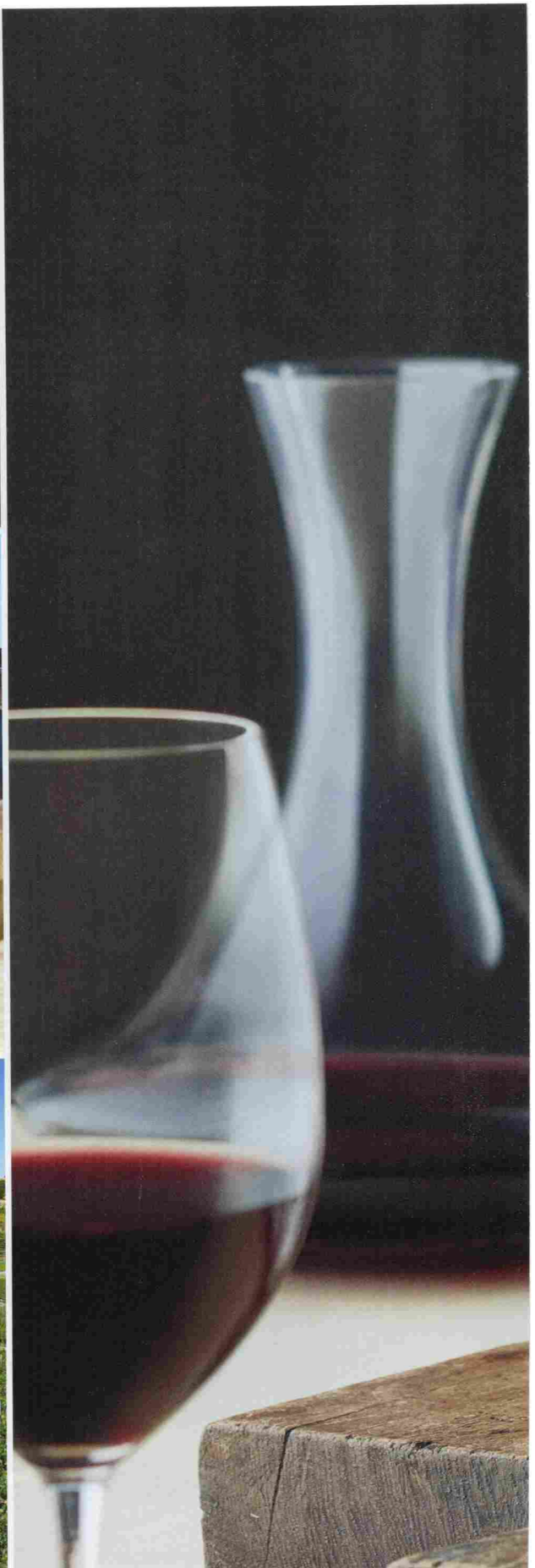

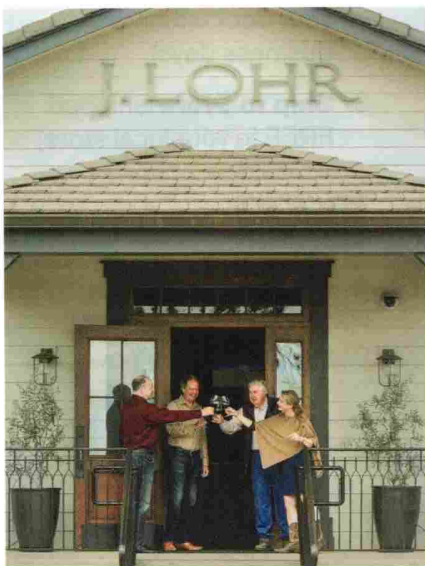

### J. LOHR

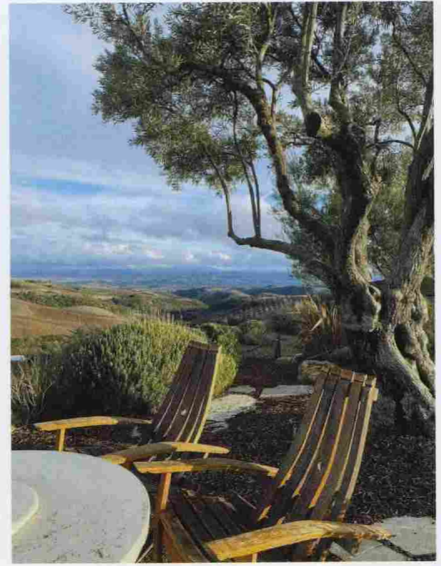
Celebrating its 50th anniversary in 2024, the family-owned and -operated J. Lohr is one of the most recognizable and beloved names in California winemaking. Its Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Merlot, Petite Sirah, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc have been instrumental in establishing and raising the reputation of Paso Robles and Arroyo Seco (in Monterey County) as top-tier wine regions.



### AUSTIN HOPE

In 1995, Austin Hope began overseeing operations at the iconic Hope Family Wines, which has been a stalwart of Paso winemaking since 1978. He founded his eponymous winery in 2000, and it was named *Wine Enthusiast's* American Winery of the Year in 2022. The Austin Hope project began with a focus on Rhône varieties, but after rigorous site selection and extensive experimentation, he added Cabernet Sauvignon in 2017.

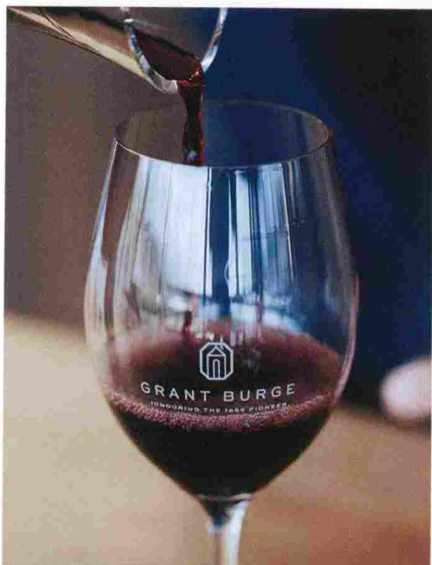
## | THE NEXT WAVE



### DAOU

Brothers Georges and Daniel founded DAOU Vineyards in 2007, but the story of this winery began in 1975 when the Daou family fled civil war in Lebanon, finding themselves first in France and later California. Today, DAOU crafts many of Paso Robles's most dynamic, terroir-driven Cabernet Sauvignon, Bordeaux-inspired blends, and mouth-watering, lithe, expressive Chardonnay.

## GRANT BURGE

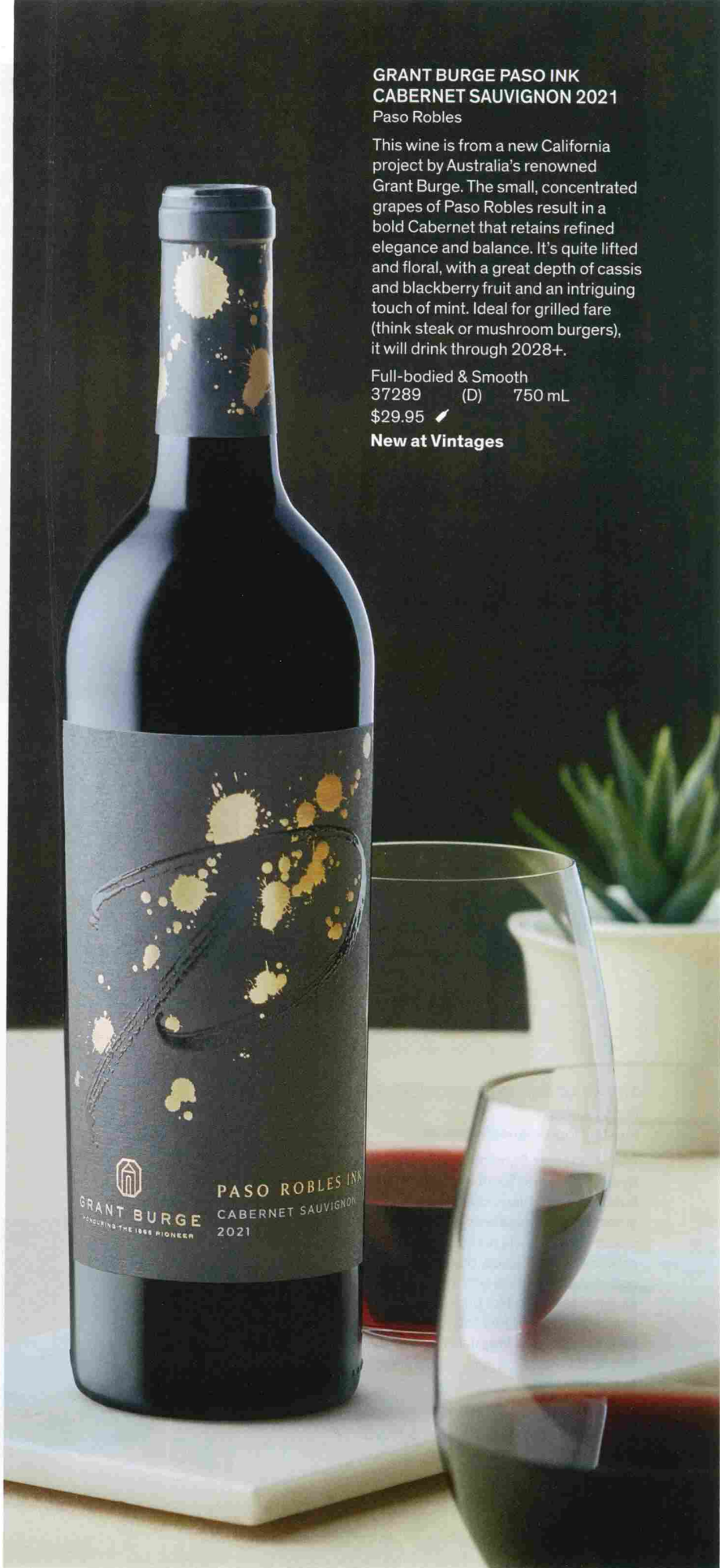
Grant Burge can trace its beginnings to the 1800s, when the Burge family first planted vines in Australia's Barossa Valley. Though they continued to operate primarily as grape growers, they began making their own wines in 1865. A pioneering spirit has always been integral to Grant Burge, and that attitude has seen it set its sights on the exciting terroir of Paso Robles.

### GRANT BURGE PASO INK CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2021 Paso Robles

This wine is from a new California project by Australia's renowned Grant Burge. The small, concentrated grapes of Paso Robles result in a bold Cabernet that retains refined elegance and balance. It's quite lifted and floral, with a great depth of cassis and blackberry fruit and an intriguing touch of mint. Ideal for grilled fare (think steak or mushroom burgers), it will drink through 2028+.

Premium-quality Paso Cabernets showcase overt blueberry, cassis and peppercorn and can be enjoyed much earlier and at a more approachable price than their broad-shouldered Napa counterparts. Napa Cabernet is king for a reason, but if you're looking for something special without breaking the bank, Paso Robles Cabernet is it.

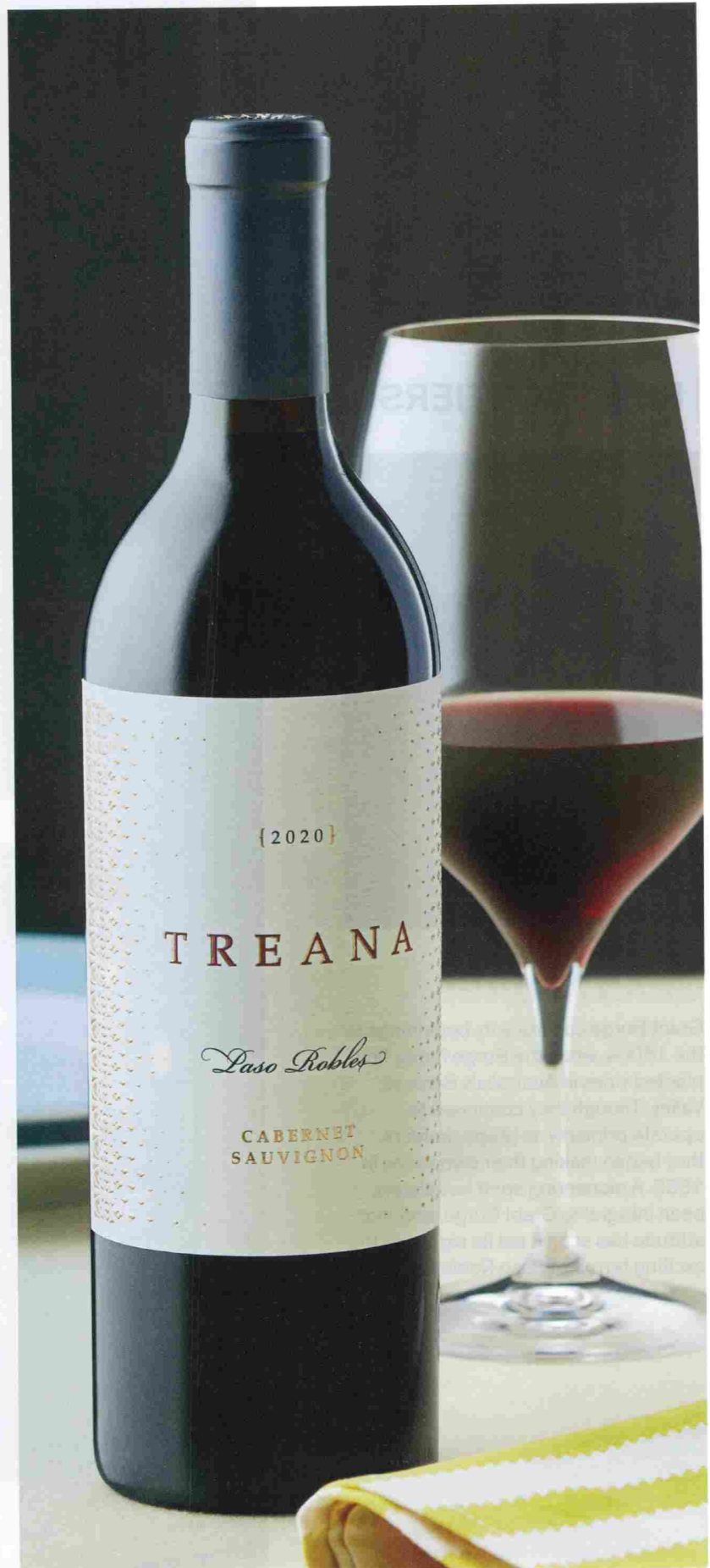

# THE RIGHT STUFF

The right half of France's wine epicentre crafts exquisite Merlot-dominant reds. From Blaye to Fronsac to Saint-Émilion to Pomerol, there are great bottles to be found all along the Right Bank.





The greater region of Bordeaux comprises two halves divided by the Gironde Estuary that are simply referred to as the Left Bank and the Right Bank. The Right Bank has the ideal conditions for growing top-quality Merlot, with low average daytime temperatures, and clay-rich calcareous soils over limestone bedrock that offer great water retention. Nowhere are these conditions more prevalent than in the subregions of Pomerol and Saint-Émilion, which offer both quaffable table wines and posh top-shelf bottles. Wines from these areas are beloved for their immense structure, velvety tannins, and incredible ageability, developing complex flavours of dried blue fruit, smoked meat, baking spices, and dark chocolate.

## WHITE GOLD

Though Bordeaux is well-known for its reds, the areas of Entre-Deux-Mers and Sauternes specialize in producing white wines using Sémillon, Sauvignon Blanc and Muscadelle. The dry whites of Entre-Deux-Mers offer a crisp texture with green, herbaceous flavours, while Sauternes has become iconic for its luscious dessert wines made in a fascinating method. Following a practice that originated in Tokaj, Hungary, vintners allow fully ripe grapes to remain on the vine, exposing them to autumnal mists that encourage the *Botrytis cinerea* fungus, commonly known as noble rot. The fungus causes the juice in the grapes to concentrate, resulting in exotic, opulent wines.
